


1. VIETNAM STEEL ASSOCIATION

REVIEW OF VIETNAM ECONOMY IN 2018

- GDP in 2018 increased by 7.08%, the highest growth since 2011, surpassing the Government's target of 6.7%;
- The inflation was 3.54% below the target of 4% set by the National Assembly;
- Export turnover reached nearly US\$ 245 billion, a rise of 13.8% compared to 2017;
- Import revenue in 2018 reached an estimate of US\$ 237 billion, moving up by 11.5% from the previous year. So that, trade surplus of US\$ 8 billion in 2018 (FOB price exchange);




OUTLOOK FOR VIETNAM ECONOMY IN 2019

The main objectives of Vietnam Government in 2019 are: Macro-economic stability; Controlling inflation; Restructure economy and creating new model of growth.

- ► For 2019, the National Assembly of Vietnam has approved the targets for socio-economic development:
- GDP growth rate: 6.8%;
- Export growth rate: 8-10%;
- Trade deficit: maintained at 2% of total export revenue;
- CPI below 4%;



 After more than 50 years of development, Vietnam steel industry has become an important industry in the economy.








CHART OF STEELMAKING RAW MATERIALS PRICES IN 2019





DOMESTIC STEEL BILLETS PRICE IN 2018



- The year 2018 was considered a challenging year for Vietnam's steel industry.
- ❖ For the whole year 2018, crude steel production of Vietnam reached more 15 million tons, ranking 16th position in world crude steel production.
- Specifically, the production and consumption of finished steel products increased by 16% and 3% y-o-y respectively, details as the next slide.





The chart of production and consumption of finished steel products in 2018, details as below:






Chart of Major Long Products Producers

Domestic Market share of TOP 5 Metallic & Color Coated Sheets producers



Chart of Major Steel Pipes Producers





Apparent Consumption of all finished steel products:

❖ Vietnam Steel Consumption per capita reached ~241 kg, the 4th ASEAN country.

Imports:

- In 2018, imports of finished steel products from China
- ~ 6.27 million tons, down 10% in volume, but up 9.8% in value over 2017; The proportion of imported steel from this country accounts for ~ 46.3% of total imported steel products.
- Followed by Japan (16.5%), Korea (12.6%), Taiwan (10.6%), India (4.5%) and Russia (4.06%).



Prices and Quantity of Steel Imported into Vietnam in 2018




Exports:

- ❖ In the whole year 2018: Exports of semi and finished steel products reached more than 7.8 million tons, an increase of 40% in volume, with export turnover reaching more than US \$ 5.7 billion.
- ASEAN remained the main export market, with finished steel exports of over 3.5 million tons, accounting for more than 56% of Vietnam's total finished steel exports


Top 10 largest destinations for steel exports of Vietnam in 2018

Trade cases initiated by Vietnamese steel producers. So far, Vietnam has initiated 7 trade case investigations involving steel:

- Anti-dumping for stainless steel- AD01 (5/9/2014)
- Anti-dumping for galvanized steel products- AD02 (30/3/2016)
- Global self defense for steel billet and longs products -SG04 (18/7/2016)
- Antidumping for H-shaped steel AD03 (21/8/2017)
- Global self-defense for color sheets SG05 (31/5/2017)
- ❖ Anti-circumvention trade defense measures for steel wire/ wire rod -AC01.SG04 (26/7/2018).
- Anti-dumping against colored sheets AD04 (15/10/2018)



Lawsuits related to export steel products. So far (since 2004), there are total 47 cases involving exported Vietnamese steel products from 11 economies such as the EU, the US, Brazil, Canada, Australia, Turkey, India, Columbia, Malaysia, Thailand, Indonesia) in different forms:

- Anti-dumping- AD: 29 cases;
- Countervailing Duty- CVD: 3 cases;
- AD & CVD: 3 cases;
- Safeguard SG: 9 cases;
- Anti circumvention AC: 3 cases.








- The economic situation in the first month of 2019 continues the positive trend, continues to keep the progress of steel industry development
- ■With the average growth rate 10% y-o-y, Vietnam will produce about 30 million tons finished steel products in 2020. Of which, long products will be approximately 45%, and flat products about 55%.



- In 2019, Vietnam will put some projects into production such as:
- -Steel Making mill in Nghi Son, Thanh Hoa;
- -HoaPhat Dung Quat with the BF in Quang Ngai;
- Other projects applying licenses as Sunpro –
 Hau Giang, Dong Nam A Steel Gia Lai.



ASEAN-6 is on track to return to its near term steel demand growth potential of 5-6% per annum and total steel consumption is expected to surpass 80 mt in 2019.

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

- CR coil;
- Galvanized steel sheet and color coating;
- Welded steel pipe;
- Construction steel and billet, etc.
